Bikes/e-bikes on School Grounds

To ensure the safety of all members of our school community, we would like to reinforce an important school expectation: students and parents must not ride bikes or e-bikes on school grounds.

All students are required to dismount at the school entrances and walk their bikes while on school grounds. This expectation is in place to protect pedestrians, particularly during busy arrival and departure times when pathways are crowded.

We also ask for the support of our parents and carers in modelling this expectation. By demonstrating safe behaviours and reinforcing this message at home, you play an important role in helping students understand and follow school rules.

Parents – Be safe - please - no riding of bikes/e-bikes on school grounds

Thank you for the parents who are parking and locking their bikes/e-bikes inside the school gates in the mornings and afternoons.

We also appreciate e-bike riders who respectfully follow requests by school staff to dismount their bikes on school grounds.

Student safety is a shared responsibility, and we appreciate your ongoing cooperation in keeping our school environment safe for everyone.

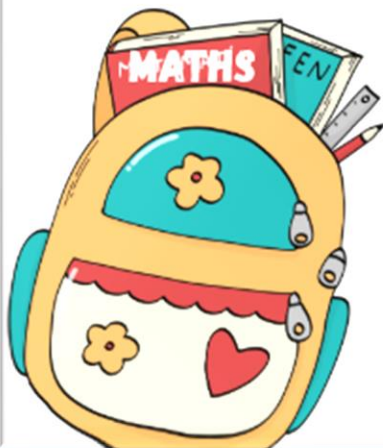
