This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving in the Upper 2 Bands in Naplan Reading, Writing and Mathematics.
- Provide additional support to those students with significant needs academically, socially and/or emotionally.

Our initiatives include

- Planning days to ensure systemic curriculum delivery, lower variation of explicit teaching and effective differentiation.
 - Whole school refinement of teacher data
 - Differentiated pathways are planned for various ability groups of students in response to analysis of data
 - Instructional methods matched to phases of learning, including small group guided teaching
 - Differentiated classroom teaching documented and tracked for accountability
 - Continued PD, planning, modelling, coaching and resourcing to deliver differentiation in class teaching
 - Early intervention and remediation for Prep – Year 3
 - STEAM Program implemented across the whole school
 - End of year whole school data analysis (e.g. effect size, benchmarks, achievement targets) to ascertain distance travelled and effectiveness of differentiation for each student
 - Support for those students with complex needs academically, socially and/or emotionally.
 - Increased office staff support to enhance school community initiatives.
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
Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Provide funding to allow Teacher release to plan for teaching and learning and to moderate - \$30,000
- Provide extra funding for a Maths Teacher to provide targeted extension work for identified students - \$46,271
- Provide funding for STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics) resources - \$18,000
- Provide extra teacher aide support for Learning Support - \$30,000
- Provide extra funding for a STEAM Teacher to deliver lessons in STEAM - \$24,016
- Provide extra funding to support our students with complexity (academically, socially and/or emotionally) through extra targeted human resources - \$25,000
- Provide extra funding for a Stephanie Alexander Kitchen Garden Teacher - \$53,058
