This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving in the Upper 2 Bands in Naplan Reading, Writing and Mathematics.
- Provide additional support to those students with significant needs academically, socially and/or emotionally.

Our initiatives include

- Planning days to ensure systemic curriculum delivery, lower variation of explicit teaching and effective differentiation.
- Whole school refinement of teacher data
- Differentiated pathways are planned for various ability groups of students in response to analysis of data
- Instructional methods matched to phases of learning, including small group guided teaching
- Differentiated classroom teaching documented and tracked for accountability
- Continued PD, planning, modelling, coaching and resourcing to deliver differentiation in class teaching
- Early intervention and remediation for Prep – Year 3
- End of year whole school data analysis (e.g. effect size, benchmarks, achievement targets) to ascertain distance travelled and effectiveness of differentiation for each student
- Support for those students with complex needs academically, socially and/or emotionally.

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Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Provide resources for programs such as Multi-Lit coupled with teacher aide support to deliver these programs in Prep - \$52,440
- Provide funding to allow teacher release to plan for teaching and learning and to moderate student work - \$32,500
- Provide funding to support identified students through the Student Services Team - \$55,850
- Provide extra funding for a Maths teacher to provide targeted extension work for identified students - \$50,000
- Provide extra funding for a Stephanie Alexander Kitchen Garden Teacher - \$49,907
